## Prayer of the Faithful

**Fr Simon writes:** This week marks the moment 40 days after the Resurrection when our Lord ascended into heaven (Mass SMM 6pm on 13 May and at CTK 7pm on 14<sup>th</sup> May). In the early church on Ascension Day, you would expect Christians to have assembled in Jerusalem somewhere near the Mount of Olives, where it all happened (Acts 1.9-12). In fact, they gathered at **Bethlehem!** This shows the early Church understood the great significance of the Ascension - that the God who fully shared our human nature (displayed fully at Bethlehem where Jesus was born) took that humanity back to heaven when he ascended - he did not remove or shake off his humanity when he ascended. This has *massive* implications for our attitude to the poor, the disabled, the elderly, the migrant, the mentally ill and all those looked upon as less than human by our society.

**Pope Leo's Prayer intentions for May:** When we pray for the Pope's intentions at the beginning of the Rosary, our Holy Father asks us during May for a fairer distribution of food around the world.
